



## **1976 to 1980 Kart Proposal**

**This amendment proposal is being presented to the membership for their consideration**

### **General**

**1976-1980 karts:** This proposal will allow the addition of karts manufactured during the years of 1976 to 1980 to be restored, presented for kart show awards and run in all future Vintage Kart Club of America (VKCA) events, both Major events and Play Days.

**Mission Statement:** Amend the Mission Statement to reflect the addition of the 1976 to 1980 karts. If passed, the Mission statement shall read: *The Vintage Kart Club of America (VKCA) was formed by a group of vintage kart enthusiasts interested in promoting and preserving the appreciation, recognition and restoration of vintage karts manufactured in the era from 1956 through 1980.*

### **Event Participation**

**Events:** It is recognized that karts from the era of 1976-1980 have both a speed and handling advantage over older karts, and both may be on the track at the same time. It is up to the participant to recognize this fact, and drive in a safe and courteous manner. The Event organizers likewise will observe that the addition of a separate run group during open sessions may be necessary in order to maintain a safe level of karts on the track at any one time. The 1976-1980 group will have it's own demonstration heat at Major Events.

**Kart Shows:** The 1976-1980 group of karts will be judged following the philosophy of the VKCA Mission Statement by respecting the historical significance of vintage karts and compliance for this era of karts.

### **Kart Guidelines, 1976-1980 Karts**

- 1) Rear axle: 1" diameter maximum.
- 2) Nerf bars: short nerf bars only. Full length nerf bars are not allowed.
- 3) Bodywork: Not allowed. Exception: Nassau, or number panels mounted over the steering column are allowed.
- 4) Front Tire maximum width:
  1. 1976-1977: 3.60-10.0-5
  2. 1978-1980: 4.50-10.0-5
- 5) Rear Tire maximum width:
  1. 1976-1977: 6.00-11.0-5
  2. 1978-1980: 7.10-11.0-5
- 6) Tire Durometer: 65 or harder.
- 7) Clutch: Disc clutches not allowed on karts prior to 1976. Third bearing supports for disc clutches strongly recommended.
